We finished our 1st focus in our study on pets. We talked about what we know about pets and what we wanted to find out. We began our 2nd focus which is finding out the characteristics of pets and what kind of animals are pets. We talked about how pets mostly live in or around our houses, they are tame and not dangerous and we can touch them. We read about a book about a fish in Swimmy, a dog in Whistle for Willie and a cat in Cookie's Week.
